2024 has been a benchmark year, setting the stage for even more exciting developments coming in 2025:

- We have a dynamic new website which increased our visitorship, school tours, and private events;
- We hosted both the Torrance and Palos Verdes Chambers at events promoting the
 museum:
- We inaugurated our Kids Aerospace Discovery Zone which has been enormously popular with families and proved its worth as an educational play area;


